SDAHQ is locally affiliated with the South Dakota Association of Healthcare Organizations (SDAHO).

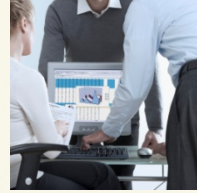
National Affiliation
