

Phases of the Project

- In year 1 and 2 of the grant, the focus of integrating SBIRT into clinics will occur in Sioux Falls with Avera clinics
- Beginning in year 2 through year 3 the project will expand to central SD
- Beginning in year 3 through year 4 into year 5 the project will expand to western, SD
- The project will wrap up at all sites during year 5





Interim Evaluation Update

Screening Results

The SBIRT screening process is designed with the intent of determining the level of services appropriate for the willing patient. There are three screening tools used for the screen each with independent scores appropriate for services:

	Brief Intervention (BI)	Brief Treatment (BT)	Referral for Treatment (RT)
AUDIT	8-15	16-19	20+
DAST 10	1-2	3-5	6+
PHQ-9	5-14	15-19	20+

Also included is a single tobacco question requiring a simple yes or no response to current use.


^{*}Prior to March 1, 2017 an AUDIT score of 3 for women and people over 65 and 4 for men qualified as a positive pre-screen.



Screening Outcomes January 30, 2017 through June 2, 2017

 Approximately 40-50% of positive screens included patients who were positive on more that one assessment tool.

SBIRT screenings recorded from 1/30/2017 to 6/2/2017.



Level of Service	% Clients with Eligible Scores
Brief Intervention (BI)	85%
Brief Treatment (BT)	10%
Referral to Treatment (RT)	5%
