Effective March 2, 2020, it is the expectation of the Office of Health Care Facilities Licensure and Certification ALL individuals who are being hired or are independently enrolling in a CNA training and testing program will complete the initial application process <u>prior</u> to the start of the training program; and receive confirmation that following successful completion of a training program and the Nurse Aide Competency Evaluation they would be eligible for active registry status.

For those individuals who have already enrolled and started in a training program, please have them complete the initial application process as soon as possible prior to completion of the training and testing.

Please provide a copy of the attached instructions to the individual seeking employment as a CNA so they may complete the initial application process.

Program coordinators and/or instructors follow included instructions to go to site for confirmation of individual eligibility prior to enrolling and starting program.
