SESSION DESCRIPTIONS

These session descriptions were developed by SDAHO and the USD Beacom School of Business. These courses are based off of existing USD Executive Education and were customized to meet the needs of South Dakota healthcare leaders.

Session 1: Creative Thinking & Problem Solving – January 16, 3-4:30pm, CST

When problems arise, do you make a list of possible causes, prioritizing them in the order of probability that they actually contribute to the problem?
