- All members will have access to the SDAHO Education Portal. This site will include links to register, recordings, attestations for continuing education, and handouts.
- SDAHO will continue to provide weekly updates on education opportunities through the Unified Voice Newsletter, website, and social media to keep members engaged and aware of current and upcoming education.
