



#### Grant Lifecycle



#### What is meant by Pre-award?

- Activities that occur prior a grant being submitted
  - Searching for funding
  - Reviewing funding announcements
  - Writing the application, budget, develop the proposal
  - Identify partners, create network



#### What is meant by Post-award?

- Activities that occur once a grant is awarded
  - Reviewing the grant agreement, notice of award
  - Meeting with the project team
  - Implementing and managing the project
  - Reporting

#### What is meant by Closeout?

- Activities that occur when the grant is almost complete
  - Final reports
  - Review documents, update files
  - Prepare for possible audit


