

Rural Emergency Hospital Designation Update:

Session

The REH program is officially available under CMS effective January 1, 2023. This alternative program will provide a much needed safety net to a specific group of financially struggling CAH and smaller rural PPS facilities. CMS rules continue to be finalized on the Conditions for Participation as well as the reimbursement methodology. At the same time individual states are scrambling to enact rules around state licensure and Medicaid reimbursement. This session will discuss what is known regarding finalized rules and guidance as well as define those areas that still require rule making and further clarification.
