July 9 - Understanding Reimbursement Systems in Skilled Nursing Facilities

Learn how reimbursement is calculated and operational strategies fto drive accurate and timely reimbursement. The course also provides an in-depth look at the methodology and philosophy behind the Patient Driven Payment Model (PDPM), including variable per diem adjustments and case-mix adjusted components.

July 16 - Documentation and Coding Accuracy

Gain an understanding of how documentation supports MDS accuracy, common pitfalls that lead to revenue loss or compliance risk, and strategies to align interdisciplinary team efforts. Real-world scenarios and documentation examples and practical tips will be shared to improve coding precision, support regulatory compliance, and optimize facility reimbursement.

July 23 - Medicare Advantage and Managed Care – Challenges, Compliance & Reimbursement Strategies

Gather clarity on how these plans differ from Traditional Medicare, what challenges facilities commonly face, and how to develop proactive workflows to reduce denials and optimize reimbursement. Real-world case scenarios and strategies will be discussed to promote better outcomes and financial sustainability.

July 30 - Optimizing Reimbursement in Skilled Nursing Facility

Discover how to optimize reimbursement and avoid missed opportunities through an astute understanding of the nuances of the PDPM payment model. The course will concentrate on the elements that have the greatest influence on reimbursement. Gain an understanding of the importance of flexibility with Medicare assessment scheduling and the importance of gathering timely and accurate assessment data for optimal reimbursement.

August 6 - SNF Quality Reporting Program Impact on Reimbursement

This session will provide an overview of the SNF QRP, and quality measures used in the program. Participants will gain an understanding of how SNFs collect and submit data to CMS, including the deadlines and submission requirements and how to monitor for compliance with these requirements.

August 13 - Leveraging Technology and Data Analytics to Drive Quality Outcomes

Explore how nursing facilities can harness technology and data analytics to improve clinical decision-making, monitor performance metrics, and enhance resident outcomes. The session will highlight practical tools, a recommended iQIES Reporting run schedule and the importance of integrating data into daily quality improvement processes.
